P.E. POLICY

OUR AIMS

At Sir William Burrough we aim to:

Promote a positive and enjoyable attitude to physical activity and healthy life styles.

Ensure safe practice amongst all children.

Develop in all children a sense of self worth and an appreciation of the differing abilities of others.

OUR STRATEGIES

Every child at Sir William Burrough in KS1 is entitled to have experience of three areas of activity; Games, Gymnastic Activities and Dance, using indoor and outdoor environment where appropriate.

Throughout the key stage pupils will be taught:

about changes that occur to their bodies as they exercise,

to recognise the short-term effects of exercise on the body.

Every child at Sir William Burrough in KS2 is entitled to have experience of six areas of activity. During each year of the key stage, children will be taught Games, Gymnastic Activities, and Dance. At points during the key stage, children will be taught Athletic Activities and Swimming.

Throughout the key stage children will be taught;

how to sustain energetic activity over appropriate periods of time in a range of physical activities.

the short term effects of exercise on the body.

PE will be planned within the overall framework of the curriculum and on a half termly basis within each academic year. All classes are time-tabled to have one hall time PE session per week and one playground PE session per week. Each session will be of a duration of 45 minutes.

Children will be taught in groups of up to 30 by their class teachers in the hall or playground where appropriate.

Children will work individually, or in groups, or as a whole class depending on the activity.

Individual Education Plans will be used to identify the support necessary to meet the needs of SEN children in physical education. The SENCO will be available to advise on a any matters.

OUR RESOURCES

Every child at Sir William Burrough has access to:

a range of balls, bats, skipping ropes etc.

a range of both small and large apparatus.

during KS2 every child will have access to a swimming pool.

there is a locked PE storeroom on the top floor.

there is a locked PE store room at the bottom of the back staircase.

OUR CURRICULUM LEADER

we will use National Curriculum level descriptors at the end of each key stage for each child.

OUR SUCCESS CRITERIA

We expect 80% of our children to achieve at or above the national standards for PE as measured in level descriptors.
